Science institute holds open house

The Elementary Institute of Science here will hold a 2-hour open house Sunday following a ribbon-cutting at 1 p.m.

The \$6 million facility, which will serve 350 to 400 young scientists a year, opened in August but has been waiting for elevators to be installed.

"We're in business now for real," said executive director Doris Anderson.

The institute is at 608 51st St., next to the Malcolm X Library in Emerald Hills, and features after-school programs in biology, natural sciences, computer sciences and engineering for children between 7 and 13.

Students, teachers and board members launched a grass-roots campaign to raise \$6 million for the institute.
